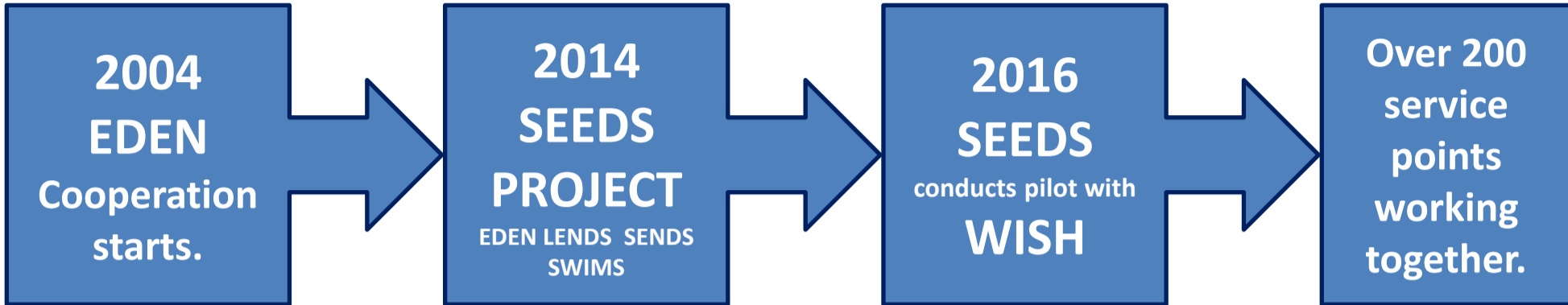


Partnerships are Central to Success
